WARNING

CHROME PLATE MAINTENANCE

Whilst all chrome-plated parts used on Jaguar cars are produced to a high standard, owners should note that deterioration of the plate may occur unless regular maintenance treatment is given.

With cars that are washed frequently and not operated in areas where climatic conditions liable to affect chrome plate exist, normal washing and leathering of the chrome and occasional use of chrome polish will maintain the plate in satisfactory condition.

In certain industrial areas or coastal areas, however, discoloration of the chrome plate from deposits in the atmosphere is liable to occur and more frequent attention is required.

Particular attention is drawn to the fact that salt is now commonly used on roads for frost or snow dispersal and it is of great importance that in areas where this treatment is used cars should be washed off as quickly as possible following use under these conditions.
